

## AP students marks and not grades to be considered for DU admissions

New Delhi: The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu has advised the Union Minister for Human Resource Development, Dr. Ramesh Pokhriyal 'Nishank' to consider issuing an advisory to Boards of Higher Secondary Education or Intermediate of all States to provide marks in addition to grades to facilitate admissions into Central Universities. Naidu said that boards which issue the results in grades must also simultaneously provide marks so that the percentage obtained by the students could be calculated by the respective universities.

The Vice President called the HRD minister to his chamber in the Rajya Sabha and discussed the issue after students from Andhra Pradesh represented to him about the problem faced by them while seeking admission to Delhi University.

The Board of Intermediate Education, Andhra Pradesh introduced grading system for Intermediate first year students in the academic year 2017-18 and continued the same pattern for second year students from 2018-19. Under the grading method, the students were provided with grade points for each subject.

Since the admissions to Delhi University were based on marks percentage, the students

represented the matter to the Vice President and sought the intervention of his good offices.

Soon after the matter came to the notice of the Vice President a couple of days ago, he directed the officials to convey the concerns of the students to Delhi University authorities. Subsequent to the Vice President's intervention, Delhi University authorities took up the matter with the officials concerned.

Earlier today, Shri Naidu called the Delhi University Vice Chancellor, Shri Yogesh Kumar Tyagi and Dean, Students Welfare, Prof. Rajeev Gupta to his residence and discussed the issue thereabout.

The Vice Chancellor assured that the interests of the students would be protected and that the admissions would be based on marks percentage and not on grades and CGPA.

The University authorities have also sent mails and SMS texts to all students from Andhra Pradesh to download the marks from Intermediate board and upload them while applying in Delhi University.

In the wake of the problems faced by the students from Andhra Pradesh, the Vice President advised the HRD Minister to issue an advisory to all Boards of Higher Education Boards or Intermediate.

## Identification of Benami Properties

New Delhi: Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions Act 1988 as amended by the Benami Transaction (Prohibition) Amendment Act, 2016 seeks to prohibit the benami transactions irrespective of the method by which the benami property is acquired. Such benami transactions include transactions in respect of movable as well as immovable properties.

Till 31.05.2019, show cause notices under the Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions Act 1988 have been issued in over 2100 cases involving benami properties valued at over Rs. 9600 crores.

The Government has taken various steps to identify benami properties. The Income-tax Department (ITD) has set up 24 dedicated Benami Prohibition Units (BPU) across India. These BPUs are involved in gathering information and matching the

same with the data available for identifying the benami properties and taking effective action as per the provisions of Prohibition of Benami Property Transactions Act 1988.

Moreover, a new reward scheme titled "Benami Transactions Informants Reward Scheme, 2018" aimed at encouraging people to, inter alia, give information about benami transactions and properties has been introduced. Under the Benami Transactions Informants Reward Scheme, 2018, a person can get reward up to Rs. 1 crore for giving specific information in prescribed manner to the prescribed authorities about benami transactions and properties as well as proceeds from such properties, which are actionable under Benami Property Transactions Act, 1988. Identity of the persons giving information is not disclosed.

## The proposal of Classical language status for Marathi is under active consideration

New Delhi: A proposal for granting Classical status to Marathi Language was received from Marathi Language Department, Government of Maharashtra.

The said proposal was placed before the Committee of Linguistic Experts for its consideration. However, in the light of several Writ Petitions filed

by R. Gandhi in the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Madras on the subject, it was decided to wait for the outcome of the said Writ Petitions. The Hon'ble High Court of judicature at Madras has disposed off the Writ Petitions vide common order dated 08.08.2016 declining to interfere in the matter and disposed off all the Writ Petitions.

## Indigenous Urea Production to increase by 63.5 LMT per year: Shri D.V. Sadananda Gowda

New Delhi: Union Minister for Chemicals and Fertilizers, Shri D.V. Sadananda Gowda, while giving a written reply to a question on import of urea in the country, in Lok Sabha today, stated that in the last 3 years, average imported urea is 63.12 Lakh Metric Tonne (LMT) and average expenditure is Rs. 12,797.31 crores. The Minister informed that the average total production of urea in the country in the last three years is around 241 LMT and the total consumption (sales) is 305.48

LMT approximately. The gap is fulfilled through imports.

In view of the above, Government had announced New Investment Policy - 2012 on 2nd January, 2013 and its amendment on 7th October 2014 to facilitate fresh investment in urea sector and to make India self-sufficient in the urea sector, Shri Gowda stated.

Detailing the steps taken by Government to reduce the import burden of urea, Shri Gowda stated that under NIP-2012, read with its amendment, following urea units in private sector have been installed: -

Matix Fertilizers & Chemicals Limited (Matix) has set up a Coal Bed Methane (CBM) based Greenfield Ammonia-Urea complex at Panagarh, West Bengal with 12.7 Lakh Metric tonne per annum capacity. The commercial production of Matix started on 1st October, 2017.

Chambal Fertilizers & Chemicals Limited (CFCL) has also set up a Brownfield project at Gadepan, Rajasthan with 12.7 Lakh Metric tonne per annum capacity. The commercial

production of CFCL-III started on 1st January, 2019. The plants have manufactured 6.05 LMT of urea since commissioning.

The Minister further informed that the Government of India is also reviving 5 closed fertilizer plants, namely Talcher (Odisha)
