From 3rd May to 20th June, 2020, a total of 188 Shramik Special Trains have originated from various stations under Mumbai Suburban Section, including 69 Shramik special trains from Bandra Terminus, 73 from Borivli, 31 from Vasai Road, 2 from Dahanu Road and 13 from Palghar station. These trains were departed for Gorakhpur, Jaunpur, Gonda, Varanasi, Pratapgarh, Bhagalpur, Prayagraj, Darbhanga, Danapur, Howrah etc. Out of these 1229 trains, Mumbai division has operated highest 716 trains, Ahmedabad division 260, Vadodra division 100, Bhavnagar division 30, Rajkot division 117 and Ratlam division 6 Shramik special trains. These special trains were operated by maintaining all social distancing norms, as well as proper thermal screening of passengers, was also ensured before boarding the train. During the journey, passengers were also given free meals and packaged drinking water.

Chandigarh may impose weekend curfew to contain Covid-19 cases

Chandigarh, With the Covid-19 cases crossing the 400 mark in Chandigarh, the UT administration is mulling imposing weekend curfew in the city. The curfew, on the lines of that imposed in Mohali, will be enforced if there is a drastic increase in cases or instances of people violating social distancing norms. In Mohali, inter-district movement over the weekend is allowed only with e-passes, except for medical emergency, and all non-essential shops and services remain closed on Sunday. On Saturday, the curfew is till 5pm and after that movement is allowed only with e-passes. Punjab governor and UT administrator VPS Badnore, in the daily review meeting on Wednesday, directed all officials to enhance vigil and ensure that people violating social distancing guidelines and other hygienic instructions should be penalised through a special drive conducted by dedicated teams. Over the past few weeks, the city has seen a spike in cases coming from across the city rather than a few areas, as was the case earlier. Besides, nearly 50% of the recent cases comprise visitors to the city or their contacts. Badnore also

directed the deputy commissioner to ensure that all visitors from outside the city be monitored for detection of symptoms. "They should not be allowed to violate the quarantine stipulations," he said. The UT DGP was asked to ensure that vehicles carrying registration numbers from outstation and bringing visitors from outside were checked at the border points and their details were obtained for subsequent monitoring. Badnore emphasised the importance of citizens voluntarily following the safety guidelines, issued by health experts from time to time. He stated that though the administration was doing

whatever best possible under the circumstances, yet the primary responsibility of following guidelines remained with residents. The administrator also directed all hospitals to mandatorily test all pregnant women for Covid-19 on their admission. In Mohali, inter-district movement over the weekend is allowed only with e-passes, except for medical emergency, and all non-essential shops and services remain closed on Sunday. On Saturday, the curfew is till 5pm and after that movement is allowed only with e-passes. 2 men arrested with 50g heroin, 1.5 kg cannabis in Himachal

Shimla, Two people were arrested for possession of heroin and cannabis in two separate incidents on Thursday. One of the accused, Deepak, is

resident of Rohtak, was held with 50 gram of heroin in Rampur Bushahr. Deepak was stopped during a traffic check near Khansi. The heroin was found wrapped in a polythene bag kept in the dashboard. Police also found out that the accused had entered Himachal Pradesh without an entry pass. The accused and four police personnel have been institutional quarantined. A case under Sections of the NDPS Act has been registered against the accused. In another incident, police on Thursday morning arrested a man with 1.5 kg cannabis (charas) in Kullu. The accused, Diwan Chand, 45, is a resident of Dobhi village, Kullu. The accused was arrested by police officers who were patrolling Bhulang Bihal. During the checking, police recovered cannabis from him and he was immediately arrested. Superintendent of Police (SP) Kullu Gaurav Singh confirmed the report and said that police are conducting the investigation.

Punjab Police SI shot dead in Fazilka

Ferozepur, A Punjab Police sub-inspector (SI) was shot dead in Abohar sub-division of Fazilka district late on Wednesday night. The 32-year-old cop, Gurwinder Singh, was standing near a medical store in Basant Nagar when four men arrived in a car and shot at him thrice. The SI was rushed to a local civil hospital where he was declared brought dead. Gurwinder whose father retired as an assistant sub-inspector, was recruited in the Punjab Police in 2017. His uncle is also posted at a local police station.

A senior police official, requesting anonymity, said, "So far, it appears the cop was murdered for personal reasons. However, Ferozepur range deputy inspector general of police Hardiyal Singh Mann said the police was exploring multiple possibilities and will soon crack the case." A case was registered against unknown assailants. The victim is survived by his parents and two sisters. The SI was rushed to a local civil hospital where he was declared brought dead.

Convening monsoon session of UP legislature before August 27 a tough call

Lucknow, Convening the state legislature's monsoon session before August 27, as required under constitutional provisions, is going to be a challenge for the state government in the light of the fight against Covid-19. The legislature's budget session ended on February 28 and under constitutional provisions 'six months shall not intervene between its last sitting in one session and the date appointed for its first sitting in the next session.' Although chief minister Yogi Adityanath or any member of his council of ministers have not made any statement, the issue of holding sittings of the house amid the Covid-19 pandemic has obviously become a cause of concern. "The legislature's session will be convened at an appropriate time," said minister for parliamentary affairs Suresh Khanna. Although Khanna did not elaborate, the state government will have to keep in mind reports of spread of Covid-19 infection and make appropriate arrangements for following 'social distancing norms' whenever it decides to convene the next session of the legislature. There are reports that leader of the opposition Ram Govind Chaudhary and Samajwadi Party member Shaileendra Yadav Lalai have tested Covid positive and are undergoing treatment. The assembly has a sanctioned strength of 403 members. It has seats for 379

members. There are five vacancies in the house now. Yet, the total strength of members remains higher than the available seats. At any given time the house should have 10 per cent members in the house to complete the quorum and this may provide an option of having a low attendance in the house to follow 'social distancing norms' in the fight against Covid-19. As many houses in the country may have to meet in the next few months to meet the six-month constitutional requirement, the issue came up for discussion at a video conference that Lok Sabha speaker Om Birla had with presiding officers of state legislatures on April 21. State assembly speaker Hridaya Narain Dikshit raised the issue at the video conference and said: "This is the time to consider whether the committees of parliament or committees of state legislatures can hold meetings through video conference with certain modifications. As far as holding meetings of legislatures through video conference is concerned there may be a need to consider this. The Constitution of India provides that there should not be more than six months gap between two meetings of the houses. I understand this six-month period may be nearing completion and if a meeting is called there may be social distancing rule violation." Later this issue also came

up for discussion at the 'Smooth Functioning Committee' meeting of presiding officers that Dikshit chaired through a video conference on May 29. Now, the question arises: Will a virtual sitting of the legislature be possible? As of now, the Constitution does not provide for holding a virtual meeting of the legislature. A limited presence of members at any given time may be an option for holding a session. Members may be asked to attend the house on odd-even basis as well," said CB Pandey, former advisor to the governor and a constitutional expert.
