

Irctc Ready To Roll Over Its Tejas Express Trains Again

Ahmedabad, The Indian Railway Catering And Tourism Corporation Limited (IRCTC) a PSU of the Ministry of Railways is all set to restart the operation of its fleet of Tejas Express trains (Lucknow-New Delhi & Ahmedabad-Mumbai) again for the service of the people for catering to the growing passenger demand due the festive season. Both the trains are expected to restart operations from 17th October, 2020. The operation of these two Tejas Trains was suspended from 19th March,

2020 due to spread of Covid-19 Pandemic. On getting approval from Ministry of Railways to again start the operation of the two popular corporate trains, IRCTC is making all round preparations to ensure that the trains once started match the expectation of the people in terms of levels of services and safety and health protocols amidst the ongoing pandemic. Every alternate seat will be kept vacant following the Social distancing norms for the initial period. A Standard Operation Procedure observing Covid-19 protocol has been issued to ensure safety of the passengers. Passengers will not be allowed to exchange their seats once seated. Use of face covers/masks will be mandatory for passengers and staff. All travelers will install "Arogya Setu" app and same shall be shown as and when demanded. Detailed instructions will be given to the passengers at the time of booking of tickets. All the passengers will be provided a Covid-19 protection kit which will contain a bottle of hand sanitizers, one mask, one face shield and one pair of gloves. All the passengers will go through thermal screening and hand sanitization process before entering the coach. The coach including pantry areas and lavatories will be thoroughly disinfected at regular intervals. The luggage and baggage of the passengers will be disinfected by a staff deputized for this purpose. Cleaning and regular disinfection of frequently touched surface inside the coach will be done. The service trays and trolleys will be disinfected. Both the trains have been received very well by the rail passengers in terms of quality of services, travel experience and punctuality. IRCTC, through its special complimentary travel insurance being offered to the passengers with the feature of compensating the travelers for late running of the trains had ensured the trains are properly monitored and run on time. All these facilities will be available to the passengers after the restart of the operations of these two Tejas Trains.

IRCTC has conducted an extensive training programme to educate and train its team of employees of Tejas Trains to manage the operations of the train and provide services according to the 'New Normal' amidst COVID-19 pandemic and to follow the Standard Operating Procedure ensuring passengers safety. IRCTC started the operation of its first corporate train, the Lucknow-Delhi-Lucknow IRCTC Tejas Express Train No. 82501/02 on 4th October, 2019 while the Ahmedabad - Mumbai - Ahmedabad IRCTC Tejas Express Train No. 82901/02 hit the rails on 19th January, 2020. IRCTC promises to ensure utmost levels of travel safety and high levels of services for the passengers on-board its Tejas Express Trains. Western Railway's Various Trespassing Control Measures Yields Positive Results



Ahmedabad, Western Railway has taken several measures to control the menace of trespassing and in turn has reduced the cases of run over and injuries over WR's Mumbai suburban section. WR has worked in mission mode to tackle this problem by adopting multipronged initiatives. Shri Alok Kansal - General Manager of Western Railway has taken the onus to wipe out this major problem, majorly affecting the Mumbai's suburban section. Government of India approves Kolkata East-West Metro Corridor in Kolkata city & surrounding urban localities

Ahmedabad, Government has approved the Ministry of Railways' proposal for revised cost estimate for construction of Construction of Kolkata East West Metro Corridor Project at an estimated cost of Rs. 8574.98 crore. The project envisages construction of a Metro Corridor between Salt Lake Sector-V to Howrah Maidan in West Bengal for a total route length of 16.6 kms. The project is being implemented by Kolkata Metro Rail Corporation Limited [KMRL] which is a

CPSE under Ministry of Railways, set up as a special purpose vehicle. The pre-pandemic target for completion of their project was December, 2021. Efforts are being taken to minimise the impact of pandemic on completion of the project. The project includes immense technological challenges like tunnel below river Ganges which is the 1st transportation tunnel in India under any major river as well as Howrah Station which is one of the deepest Metro stations in India. The mega project envisions creation of an efficient transit connectivity between business district of Kolkata with industrial city of Howrah in west and Salt Lake City in east through a safe,

accessible and comfortable mode of public transport. Since this corridor connects three most important parts of the Kolkata Metropolitan Area i.e. Howrah, Business area of Kolkata and New Settlements in Salt Lake it is going to revolutionise the mass rapid transport in Kolkata and adjoining Howrah and Bidhanagar. This will connect important localities like Howrah, Sealdah, Esplanade and Salt Lake Sector-V which is an IT hub. It will integrate multiple modes of transport like the Metro, Sub-urban Railways, ferry and bus transport by constructing interchange hubs. This will ensure smooth and seamless mode of transport to lakhs of daily commuters.

Sharpshooters part of sleeper cell, target was to establish supremacy: Gurugram cops

Gurugram, A day after three members of Sube Gujar's gang were arrested after a brief exchange of gunfire in Sohna, police said probe has revealed that the main sharpshooter of Gujar's gang, Rajesh Kumar alias Fauji had recently formed a 'sleeper cell' of shooters and recruited the two arrested suspects, Kamal alias Kamli, 22, and Aman alias Sardar. Two policemen and both the arrested suspects were injured in the shootout. Police said on the directions of Sube Gujar, Fauji had formed the cell and their target was to commit a series of crimes, starting with the murder of a property dealer in Dhulela on Tuesday, to establish supremacy. Investigators said that other gang members in Gujar's gang were unaware of the recruitment of these 'silent' sharpshooters. The trio had conducted a recon for two days and assembled a cache of weapons for the murder, but they were arrested after the crime branch sector 39 received a tip-off.

Leopard kills 7-year-old in Uttarakhand, 4th child killed within a month

Dehradun, A 7-year-old girl died in yet another leopard attack in Uttarakhand's Pithoragarh district late on Wednesday evening. This was the fourth case of a child getting killed by a leopard in the past one month in the state. Divisional forest officer of Pithoragarh, Vinay Bhargava said the incident happened in Bhatti village in Berinag sub-division of the district. "The incident occurred on Wednesday evening when the 7-year-old was attacked by a leopard outside her house. The animal took her to a nearby bush when villagers rushed to rescue her after listening to her cries. The leopard then left the prey and fled from there," said Bhargava. According to the DFO, the forest department has installed a cage to catch the leopard and has alerted the villagers against letting their children come out of houses without being accompanied by elders. "Himalayan fish" to boost economy of hilly areas. In the last one month, four children have been killed in leopard attacks. On October 1, a 14-year-old boy was killed in a leopard attack in Pauri Garhwal district, when he took his cattle for grazing in the forest area. On September 24, an 11-year-old girl was killed in a leopard attack in Pithoragarh district when she was collecting fodder near her house. On September 19, a 7-year-old girl was mauled to death by a leopard when she was playing near her house in Almora district, and on September 22, a 40-year-old man was also killed by a leopard in the Pithoragarh district.

27-year-old unemployed engineer dies by suicide in Dehradun

Dehradun, A 27-year-old man died by suicide at his home on Wednesday afternoon in Dehradun's Indra Colony area. He was an engineer but was unemployed, police said. No suicide note was found from the man. The Kotwali police station of Dehradun got information about the suicide from the hospital where he was taken by his family. He used to live with his family including his parents and three brothers in the Indra Colony area where he took the drastic step in the afternoon," said Arun Mohan Joshi, senior superintendent of police, Dehradun.

been raised to reduce the gap between platforms and coach floor thereby bringing the deaths due to falling in gap to almost nil. Divider-fencing has been provided between two tracks in station area over the Churchgate - Virar section to avoid persons crossing from one platform to another across the tracks, except at four locations due to space constraints. These fencing are even continued beyond platforms at identified locations where trespassing is noticed at the end of platforms. Another major cause of trespassing are the encroachments along the railway tracks. Drives for encroachment removal are regularly being carried out. In 2019, more than 600 encroachments were removed from various locations while upto July 2020, total 978 encroachments were removed from various locations. Boundary wall is available in 75.44 % of the total length of Churchgate - Virar section. Out of the total length, both on east & west sides of Churchgate - Virar section, boundary wall is not required in 12.9 km length due to river, manholes, drain etc. A length of 16.53 km was constructed in last few years. The work on the construction of new boundary wall for the balance portion of 17.10 km is being done at a fast pace. The structures & OHE Mats which were close to the tracks have been either removed or augmented to avoid the possibility of hitting the foot board travellers. Where it was not possible to shift, the structures have been painted in bright colours so as to warn the foot board travellers. Shri Thakur stated that several public awareness campaigns has been done such as appeals to commuters by roping-in celebrities, running campaigns in collaboration with NGOs, etc. Also, awareness messages are relayed through announcements at stations, SMSes, TV channels, Radio Channels, Cinema Halls, social media platforms.
